In 1950 Arthur Hoag discovered a cosmic phenomenon that has come to be known as a Hoag's Object. A Hoag's Object is a galaxy contained within a galaxy. Hoag's Object is observable in the Ophiuchus constellation.


Finished Measurements:
Length: approx. 56 in.
Width: approx. 20 in.

## Materials:

Yarn: Plymouth Yarn Baby Alpaca Brush 6 skeins (110 yds./50 grams) 660 yards total or 660 yards of worsted weight yarn

Needles: Size 1122 in. circular needles

Other Materials: tapestry needle, row counter, life line (if desired), stitch markers (if desired)

Gauge: 16 st./16 rows=4 in. in stitch pattern using size 11 needles. Gauge is not critical for this project.

## Pattern Notes:

CO: cast-on
BO: bind-off
st(s): stitch/stitches
k: knit
p; purl
ws: wrong side
rs: right side
wrap 3 stitches: with yarn held in front slip the next three stitches purlwise from the left hand needle to the right hand needle. Move yarn to the back and slip the same three stitches from the right hand needle back to the left. Knit all three wrapped stitches.
yo: yarn over
k3tog: knit the next 3 stitches together (2 stitches decreased)
k3tog tbl: knit the next 3 stitches together through the back loop (2 stitches decreased)
kfbf: knit into the front, the back, and the front of the next stitch (2 stitches increased)
kfb: knit into the front and back of the next stitch (1 stitch increased)
k2tog: knit the next 2 stitches together
sli kı psso: slip the next stitch knitwise from the left hand needle to the right hand needle, knit the next stitch, pass the slipped stitch over the knit stitch (1 stitch decrease)
ktbl: knit through the back loop.
slı k2tog psso: slip the next stitch knitwise from the left hand needle to the right hand needle, knit the next 2 stitches together, pass the slipped stitch over the stitches knit together (2 stitches decreased).
work $\mathbf{5}$ tog: first, slip the next stitch knitwise from the left hand needle to the right hand needle, knit the next stitch, pass the slipped stitch over the knit stitch, then knit the next 3 stitches together, finally pass the stitch from the first step over the three stitches that were knit together (4 stitches decreased)


## Pattern:

Using a long tail cast-on, loosely CO 79 stitches.

## Section 1:

k 4 rows
Row 1 (ws) (beginning of lace chart): k 3 , p 73 , k 3 (repeat for all ws rows)
Row 2 (rs): k11, *wrap three stitches, k15* repeat from * to * 2 more times, wrap three stitches, k11
Row4: k9, *k3tog, yo, kfbf, yo, k3tog tbl, k11* repeat from * to * 2 more times, k3tog, yo, kfbf, yo, k3tog tbl, k9
Row 6: k7, *k3tog, yo, k2tog, yo, kfbf, yo, slı k1 psso, yo, k3tog tbl, k7* repeat from * to * 3 more times

Row 8: k6, *(k2tog, yo 3 times), ktbl, (yo, sl1 k1, psso 3 times), $k 5 *$ repeat from * to * 2 more times, (k2tog, yo 3 times), ktbl, (yo, slı kı, psso 3 times), k6

Row 10: k7, *(yo, k2tog 2 times), yo, sl1 k2tog psso, (yo, sl1 k1 psso 2 times), yo, k7* repeat from * to * 3 more times
Row 12: k6, *(slı k1 psso, yo 3 times), ktbl, (yo, k2tog 3 times), k5* repeat from * to *2 more times, (slı k1 psso, yo 3 times), ktbl, (yo, k2tog 3 times), k6
Row 14: k7, *kfb, yo, slı k1 psso, yo, work 5 tog, yo, k2tog, yo, kfb, k7* repeat from * to * 3 more times
Row 16: k9, *kfb, yo, work 5 tog, yo, kfb, k11* repeat from * to * 2 more times, kfb, yo, work 5 tog, yo, kfb, k9

Repeat rows 1-16 one more time.
Repeat rows 1-2 one more time.
Repeat $\underline{\text { ALL }}$ of section 1 one more time, including the beginning k4 rows.

## Section 2:

k 4 rows
Row 1 (ws) (beginning of lace chart): k 3 , p 73 , k 3 (repeat for all ws rows)
Row 2 (rs): k11, *wrap three stitches, k15* repeat from * to * 2 more times, wrap three stitches, k11
Row4: k9, *k3tog, yo, kfbf, yo, k3tog tbl, k11* repeat from * to * 2 more times, k3tog, yo, kfbf, yo, k3tog tbl, k9
Row 6: k7, *k3tog, yo, k2tog, yo, kfbf, yo, slı k1 psso, yo, k3tog tbl, k7* repeat from * to * 3 more times

Row 8: k6, *(k2tog, yo 3 times), ktbl, (yo, slı k1, psso 3 times), k5* repeat from * to * 2 more times, (k2tog, yo 3 times), ktbl, (yo, slı k1, psso 3 times), k6
Row 10: k7, *(yo, k2tog 2 times), yo, slı k2tog psso, (yo, slı k1 psso 2 times), yo, k7* repeat from * to $* 3$ more times
Row 12: k6, *(sli k1 psso, yo 3 times), ktbl, (yo, k2tog 3 times), $k$; repeat from * to * 2 more times, (slı k1 psso, yo 3 times), ktbl, (yo, k2tog 3 times), k6
Row 14: k7, *kfb, yo, sli k1 psso, yo, work 5 tog, yo, k2tog, yo, kfb, k7* repeat from * to * 3 more times
Row 16: k9, *kfb, yo, work 5 tog, yo, kfb, k11* repeat from * to * 2 more times, kfb, yo, work 5 tog, yo, kfb, k9

Repeat rows 1-16 4 more times.
Repeat rows 1 and 2 one more time.

## Section 3:

k 4 rows
Row 1 (ws) (beginning of lace chart): k 3 , p 73 , k 3 (repeat for all ws rows)
Row 2 (rs): k11, *wrap three stitches, k15* repeat from * to * 2 more times, wrap three stitches, k11
Row4: k9, *k3tog, yo, kfbf, yo, k3tog tbl, k11* repeat from * to * 2 more times, k3tog, yo, kfbf, yo, k3tog tbl, k9
Row 6: k7, *k3tog, yo, k2tog, yo, kfbf, yo, slı k1 psso, yo, k3tog tbl, k7* repeat from * to * 3 more times

Row 8: k6, *(k2tog, yo 3 times), ktbl, (yo, slı k1, psso 3 times), $\mathrm{k} \mathrm{s}^{*}$ repeat from * to * 2 more times, (k2tog, yo 3 times), ktbl, (yo, slı k1, psso 3 times), k6
Row 10: k 7 , *(yo, k2tog 2 times), yo, slı k2tog psso, (yo, slı k1 psso 2 times), yo, $\mathrm{k}_{7}{ }^{*}$ repeat from * to * 3 more times
Row 12: k6, *(slı k1 psso, yo 3 times), ktbl, (yo, k2tog 3 times), k * repeat from * to * 2 more times, (slı k1 psso, yo 3 times), ktbl, (yo, k2tog 3 times), k6
Row 14: k7, *kfb, yo, slı k1 psso, yo, work 5 tog, yo, k2tog, yo, kfb, k7* repeat from * to * 3 more times
Row 16: k9, *kfb, yo, work 5 tog, yo, kfb, k11* repeat from * to * 2 more times, kfb, yo, work 5 tog, yo, kfb, k9

Repeat rows 1-16 one more time.
Repeat rows 1-2 one more time.
Repeat ALL of section 1 one more time, including the beginning k4 rows.
k4 rows
BO loosely
